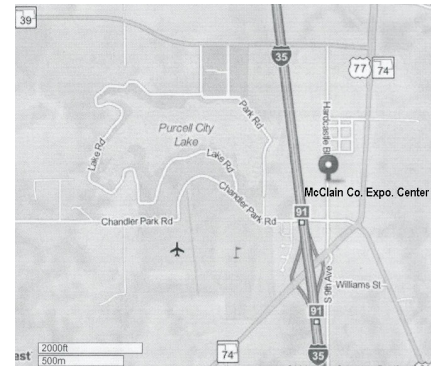


SHOW LOCATION: McClain County Expo Center
2101 Hardcastle Blvd.; Purcell, OK 73080

Please help keep the facility clean!

McClain County Expo Center is located off of Exit 91 on I-35; go north-east on Hwy. 74 towards Purcell/Lexington for approximately 1/4 mile; turn north onto South 9th Street (between the Braum's and McDonald's) for approximately 1 mile; stay straight to go onto Hardcastle Blvd. for approximately 1 mile. The Expo Center is on the west side of the road.

35 miles southeast of Oklahoma City, OK



STALLS: are 10'x10' on solid floors and are available for \$25 each. No more than (2) horses per stall; stallions and jacks age 2 & over MUST be stalled separately.

Minimum bag of 1 shavings per stall at \$9 per bag - **no outside shavings may be brought in.** If not stalled, there is a tie-out fee of \$15 per equine. Please help us keep the grounds clean.

CONCESSION: with food and drinks will be available during the show.

RV Slots: A limited number of full RV hook-ups are available for \$45 per night; with 30 & 50 amps; and dump station on site.

You may come in on Friday evening and leave by Sunday a.m.; please let the show manager know if you will be staying over.

- * Novice exhibitors are those who have not placed in the top two (2) places at any pointed show.
- ** No youth under 12 years of age may show a stallion or jack.
- *** Free fun games & hat parade to be held during the lunch break.
- **** Must be 16 years of age or older to show in Chariot Class.
- ***** Youth exhibiting in this class are asked to wear a helmet and/or protective head gear/equipment.
