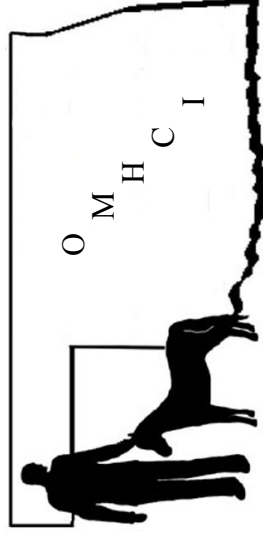

There is a membership form on the OMHCI website or available at the show if you would like to take advantage of this offer. All other fees; i.e. - office, stall, shavings charges must still be paid by the exhibitor.

Attention Pinto Mini and Pony Owners

You will now be able to become a member and register your spotted miniatures and ponies with the Pinto Horse Association of America (PthA). Also miniatures and ponies that do not meet the regular pinto requirements, may be registered under the PthA solid bred registry program.

On-site horse registry and memberships will be available at the show (for AMHA & AMHR Horses).

OMHCI is looking to promote these horses this year by offering pointed PthA classes that will run in between your regular AMHR classes. Separate PthA class and association fees will be incurred.

PRE-SHOW PAID PRACTICE

Join us on Friday evening, before the show for our pre-show paid practice warm-up. Various jumps and obstacles will be set up so that you may practice the night before our show begins. Cost is \$15 per horse and you may practice for as long as you like. You may add this onto your entry form or if you decide to practice once you get to the show, you may pay at the show office. This practice is open to registered or unregistered miniature equines (including miniature donkeys, mules or ponies). No show clothes necessary but all other show requirements (current health papers/Negative Coggins) apply.

OMHCI now accepts credit cards.

5% Service Fee will be applied.

Directions to the Expo Center: The Expo Center is located 4 miles Southeast of I-40 (Exit 181) and Hwy. 177, then turn East at the stop light on Leo St. The exact address is Heart Of Oklahoma Expo Center, 17 West Independence Street, Shawnee, Ok 77804; (405)-275-7020. There is a downloadable map on the Expo Center website - ShawneeExpo.com. Wi-Fi is available at the Expo Center. The arena is indoors but not climate controlled.



IMPORTANT - Absolutely NOTHING may be **TAPED, STAPLED, or NAILED** onto ANY surface, including stalls, on the grounds except on the designated bulletin boards. Otherwise fines will be imposed. Please help keep the facility clean. Please place trash and manure in the dumpsters outside. NO GLASS CONTAINERS and alcohol is not permitted. Thanks!

Stall Assignments - stalls will be available by 12:00 p.m. on Friday, May 17, and must be vacated by 10:00 p.m. on Sunday, May 19. These are 10' x 10' stalls, and all have concrete floors. No more than two horses will be allowed in a stall. Stallions 2 years and older MUST be stalled separately. If you wish to stay over prior arrangements must be made in advance and additional fees may apply. The horse show office, arena, restrooms and concession are all located in the same building; there are three large warm-up areas between the arena and the stall barn. There are multiple indoor wash racks.

Shavings may be purchased at the Show Office or pre-purchased on the entry form.

No outside bedding may be brought onto the show grounds.

Lunch break - will be announced at a time determined by the Show Manager.

Concession - will be available on Sat & Sun. Pizza will be available without cost to the exhibitors and show staff on Friday evening near the Show Office.

Dogs - MUST be kept on a leash or penned at all times; and animals are NOT allowed in the show office and concession area.

Smoking - is NOT permitted inside the office, barns or arena areas.

RV Hookups: There are 30 and 50 AMP RV Hookups available on the grounds.

There is also water available and a dump station on site, and numerous comfort stations with showers.

Host Hotel: When booking your rooms, please let the hotel know you are with the Oklahoma Miniature Horse Show.

This miniature horse show is approved by and conducted under the rules of the American Miniature Horse Registry (AMHR), Morton, IL. This show is accredited by the AMHR and will be conducted under the AMHR Official Show rules. This is an approved show for AMHR Division A (Under): A Halter and Performance, Division B (Over) Miniatures: A Halter and Performance. All horses MUST be registered with AMHR.

A legible copy of both sides of the Certificate of Registration of each horse entered must be submitted to the Show Manager with each horse entry. Entries that are received without a copy of both sides of the registration papers will be held pending until such papers are submitted. For geldings, gelding status must be reflected on the Certificate of Registration in order to show in any AMHR class.

If you are showing a leased horse, be sure your papers are stamped (with AMHR stamp). No cross entry is allowed between pleasure, country pleasure or western country pleasure driving - this includes open, amateur, and youth. Horses birthdates are taken from January 1st of the year being shown; youth exhibitors birthdates are from 12/1/23 to be eligible to show in their perspective classes.

Also necessary are current Youth* and Amateur AMHR cards, (and provide numbers on the entry form) **and a CURRENT NEGATIVE COGGINS;** also a current health certificate within 30 days of the show. Youth and Amateur cards may be applied for through AMHR or through the show steward. No youth under 13 years of age may show a stallion of any age, in any class. *Youth are not required to have AMHR card to exhibit. However youth exhibiting without a youth membership will not receive placings, points or be eligible for youth awards from AMHR. Youth membership is free; the first year application requires the signature of a current adult AMHR member. Yearly renewal does not require a signed form or the signature of a sponsor adult member.

Show Banner Sponsors

For those who would like to have a banner made to hang at the shows and other OMHCI events for the calendar year; the cost would be \$100. These are 2' x 4' banners and can be made up in several different colors. Please get your orders in early as it will take at least 2 weeks to get them made, and to have them available for all OMHCI events.

If you already have your own banner and would like to have it hung at events and shows the cost would be \$50. Any pre-owned banners larger than 2' x 4' will require prior approval and may be subject to a higher fee. So show off your farm, business, or horses by advertising with your banner!

Attention Buckskin Mini Owners THE ABRA MINI WORLD SHOW IS HERE!!!!

OMHCI has become a charter member club to the American Buckskin Registry Association (ABRA).

You will now be able to become a member and register your miniatures and ponies of buckskin, dun, red dun or grulla coloration with ABRA. Also miniatures and ponies that have at least one registerable ABRA parent (even if not registered) but the offspring miniature or pony does not meet the regular buckskin requirements, may be registered under the ABRA buckskin bred registry program.

On-site horse registry and memberships will be available at the show.

OMHCI is looking to promote these horses this year by offering pointed ABRA WS classes that will run in among your regular AMHA classes. Separate ABRA class and association fees will be incurred.

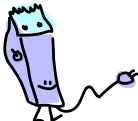

Cruelty, abuse or inhumane treatment of any horse in the show ring, barn, stalls or on the grounds is strictly prohibited. The use of stimulants or depressants or any drug affecting the showing of a horse is forbidden.

NO LOGO'S, NAMES OR OTHER IDENTIFICATION OF PERSON OR FARM WILL BE ALLOWED ON ANY EXHIBITOR, HORSE OR VEHICLE IN THE SHOW ARENA.

RETURNED CHECK FEE

OMHCI will charge a \$45.00 return check fee on all checks returned.

REFUND POLICY

A full refund will be given if entries are cancelled **in writing to the show manager before the closing date of the pre-entries**. If entries are cancelled in writing accompanied by a veterinarian's or a doctor's certificate of inability to show. After the closing date of pre-entries, but before the official start of the show, all fees other than the stall, shavings and office fees will be refunded. After the official start of the show, there will be no refunds. Substitution of a horse will be accepted with no late fee.

LIBERTY TAPES & CD's - Management is NOT responsible for any loss or damage to Liberty music. It is PREFERRED for there to be one CD or tape PER ENTRY. If there is any question as to if your CD will work on the show equipment, please have it checked with show management before turning it in for the Liberty class.

SHOW & CLASS SPONSORS - The cost of sponsoring a regular class is \$10 per class. Grand & Reserves, Championships, Stakes, Amateur & Youth High Points sponsorship is \$30 per division. Sponsors will be acknowledged during the show and are welcome to present awards for their classes. Sponsorships may be paid on the entry form; or on the class sponsorship form in the show office. Show sponsor levels are Platinum \$1K+, Gold \$500+, Silver \$100+ and Bronze \$50+ to be advertised at the show and on the website.

JUDGE'S EVALUATION FORMS - are available in the Show Office.

ALL MEASUREMENT TIMES

Friday, May 17 - 4:00 to 8:00 p.m.; and from 7:00 to 7:30 a.m. Saturday, May 18 and Sunday, May 19; or for 30 minutes following the last class of the show on Saturday. If you can't measure within these hours, contact the Show Manager. ALL Entry materials MUST be in the Show Office before measurements will be made. ALL horses entered MUST be measured before they may be allowed to show. **ALL HORSE CARDS/PAPERWORK MUST BE CHECKED AND RECORDED AT THE MEASUREMENT STATION BEFORE YOU GET YOUR PACKET.** Please bring color copies of your horse papers AND original measurement cards with you to the measurement station.

2024 CIRCUIT AWARD

Come to both 2024 OMHCI shows - May and August to be eligible for the Overall High Point show circuit champion award. A MONOGRAMMED HARNESS BAG will be given to the overall high point winning AMHR circuit champion horse. Donated by Starlite Ranch. Horses MUST be shown in a minimum of 3 classes at each show to be eligible (halter, color, showmanship, liberty, hunter, jumper, obstacle and driving). Award will be presented to the winner at the August Last Chance Showdown show.

FOUR SHOWS IN ONE WEEKEND - JOIN US FOR THE AMHA/ABRA SHOW!

Make this a combination show weekend for your registered AMHR, AMHA, ABRA WS or PtHA horse's points. The AMHR/PtHA show will begin at 8:00 a.m. on Saturday morning. The AMHA/ABRA Mini World show will begin at 8:00 a.m. on Sunday morning. See the OMHCI website for details, premiums and entry forms; separate paperwork and entry fees will apply for AMHR, AMHA, ABRA and PtHA Shows. Contact the Show Manager if you have questions.

REMEMBER: When entering a stake driving class, you must first enter the corresponding Youth, Amateur or Open class of the same division.

*Denotes non-rated class; which is not recognized by ASPC/AMHR and do not earn All Star or Hall of Fame points. ALL classes are AMHR.



ENCLOSE WITH YOUR COMPLETED ENTRIES:

1. LEGIBLE copy of EACH horse's AMHR or ASPC registration papers, FRONT & BACK.
2. Be sure papers are stamped by AMHR, if you are showing a leased horse.
3. Copy of current (2024) AMHR Youth*/Amateur card. (These may be applied for through AMHR or through the show steward).
4. A check for all fees made payable to: **OMHCI**.



All horses are required to have a negative coggins within 12 months and a health certificate within 30 days. DO NOT send these in with your paperwork, but bring them to the show; as you will NOT be able to show without them. *Youth do not need a card to exhibit, but placings, points and awards will not count.

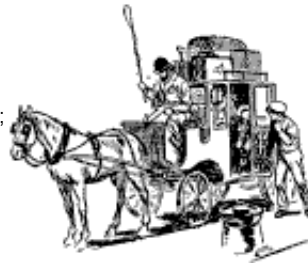

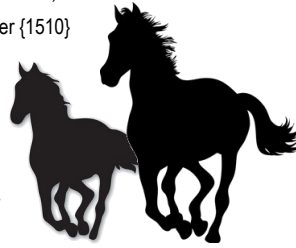

The Heart Of Oklahoma Expo Center is located 4 miles South off of I-40 (Exit 181) & Hwy. 177; the turn East at the stop light on Leo Street. The exact address is 1700 West Independence Street, Shawnee, OK. There is a downloadable map on the Expo Center website - www.ShawneeExpo.com. The map to the right is a view of the Expo Center, showing the location of the barns and RV parking. The RV spots to the West of the Expo are 30 amp only, they have water but no dump stations. All of the other spots are 30 & 50 amp, with water and dump facilities. There are also several comfort stations with showers in the RV areas.

The Hampton Inn Shawnee - is our host hotel. It is located at 4851 North Kickapoo St. (Exit 185), off of I-40. It is on the south side of I-40, approximately 4 miles from the Expo Center. There is a free hot breakfast buffet, and free Wi-Fi. They do allow service pets for an extra charge. All rooms have a coffee maker, an iron/ironing board, hair dryer, microwave and refrigerator. The hotel has an indoor pool and fitness center, business center, laundry services.

Near the hotel there is a Wal-Mart Super Center along with various other types of stores for your shopping needs or pleasure. There are also other grocery and convenience stores nearby.

As for dining, there are several restaurants - Cracker Barrel, IHOP and McDonalds are near the hotel and near the Expo Center there is Bandana Red's Steakhouse and Abuelita Rosa's Mexican Restaurant. Throughout the town there are Steakhouses, Italian, Mexican, BBQ, Asian, Seafood as well as home style American cooking and other local fares for you to choose from; and many choices of fast food restaurants.

For specialized shopping there is Shawnee Mill & Feed Center, Tractor Supply, S&S Farm Center, Atwood's, PetSmart, Lowes and Tener's Western Outfitters nearby. There are also a lot of thrift shops, antique shops, and local shopping malls.

The first buildings on the town site were built in 1881, with a Quaker Mission being built in 1885. The town itself was founded in 1893.

The railroad arrived in 1895 and the city prospered with the oil boom of the 1920's. The area surrounding Shawnee was settled after the Civil War by a number of tribes that the federal government had removed to Indian Territory. The Sac & Fox were originally deeded the land in the immediate area but were soon followed by the Kickapoo, Shawnee and Pottawatomie Indians.

Shawnee is the county seat and also the home Oklahoma Baptist University (1910) and St. Gregory's University (1875). Located in the heart of cotton, potato and peach country, Shawnee quickly became an agricultural center.

Famous people from Shawnee include Brad Pitt, Astronaut Gordon Cooper, Dr. Brewster Higley, VI - author of "Home On The Range" and athletes Jim Thorpe, Creed Humphrey and Carl Hubbell.

For other entertainment, there is the Santa Fe Depot/Pottawatomie Co. Museum, The Citizen Pottawatomie Nation Cultural Heritage Center, the Mabee-Gerrer Museum of Art, the Shawnee Little Theatre and the Cinema 8 Movie Theater. There are 2 bowling alleys and golf and there are 5 casinos in Shawnee: Black Hawk, Fire Lake, The Grand, Kickapoo and the Thunderbird.

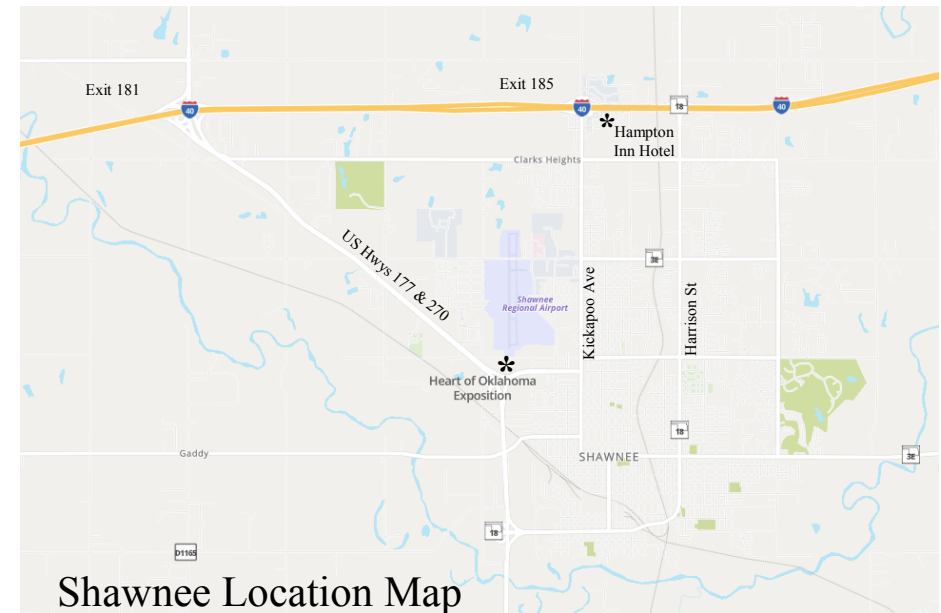
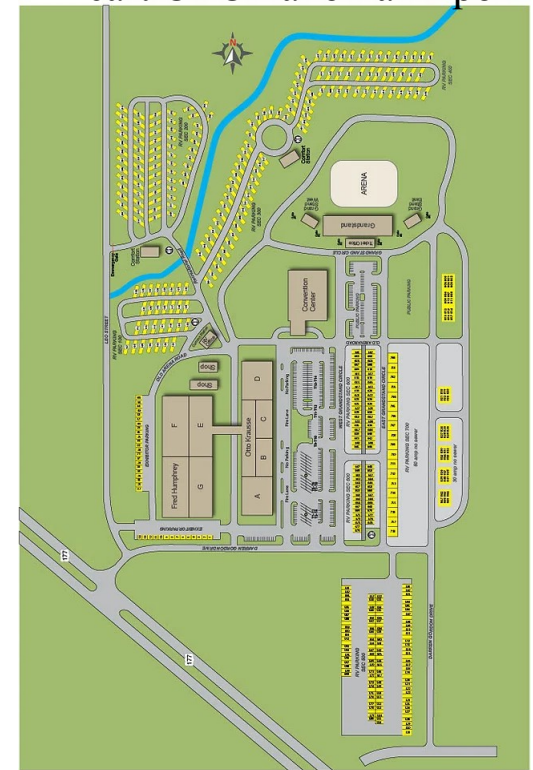
